Overland Park Eye Center remains committed to the safety of our patients and staff. Our office is currently open by appointment only and office hours may vary. We are continually monitoring the situation and will notify patients of any changes. Please call ahead for appointment availability and daily hours.

In an effort to keep our patients and staff healthy we have stepped up our already stringent sanitation efforts. Our office will continue to practice social distancing by requiring appointments for exams and order pick up, and limiting the number of people in our office at one time. Safety for our patients and staff is of the utmost importance. We are asking all patients to take the following precautions for upcoming appointments:

- Upon entry to our office all patients **MUST** wear a mask (not provided) for the duration of their office visit and utilize provided hand sanitizer.
- Attend appointment alone unless accompanying a minor or dependent (Max 1 companion).
- Please inquire with staff before trying on glasses.
- Please call our office to schedule order pick-up and to pay any remaining balance.
- If you have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, respiratory symptoms, are self/hospital quarantined by a medical doctor, have recently traveled, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days please call our office to reschedule.
